ATF have submitted their final ruling on pistol braces, a lot of existing braces are now considered stocks for the purposes of the NFA. This means that as soon as the ruling appears in the federal registry those in possession of braced firearms will have to register them as SBRs or be in violation of the NFA. Blackstone currently has stopped accepting transfers of pistol braced firearms because of this, after the ruling goes into effect we'll re-evaluate the policy. Guests that want to register their firearms as SBRs will need to go directly through the ATF to accomplish this. Guests that don't want to file will have to remove the brace from their firearm.

BLACKSTONE'S BREAKDOWN Types of Firearms



RIFLE

A firearm with a grooved barrel greater than 16" inches, designed with distance and accuracy in mind.



SHOTGUN

A firearm with a smooth barrel signed to typically fire a shell containing projectiles at once.



HANDGUN

A smaller, more compact firearm, designed to be easily transported and concealed.



RECEIVER

the heart of a firearm, the serialized portion in which all other parts attach.



SUPPRESSOR*

A device designed to attach to the end of a firearm to cut down the noise of the firearm.



SHORT BARRELED FIREARM*

A firearm with a barrel less than 16" inches equipped with a stock.

*Items fall under NFA Classification. Items require a \$200 tax stamp to be purchased and ATF form 4 approval.
